HOW IS THE SCHOLARSHIP PAID?

The financial distributions are paid out for each goal, listed below, once each goal is successfully completed. All goals must be successfully completed within 12 months of receiving the award. In the event of unforeseen circumstances where winner is unable to complete the aviation goals within one year, one six (6) month extension may be granted upon progress review. A written request must be received by the Sedona Ninety-Nines Scholarship Committee before the end of the 12 month period after receipt of the scholarship.

The indicated amounts will be paid directly to the qualified instructor or flight school on the student pilot's behalf. A qualified instructor is one with a CFI certificate in good standing. If a milestone has already been completed at the time the winner is notified, the payout for that milestone will be sent to the flight school/instructor.

FAA written examination (passed) \$750	Successful Checkride

At their own cost, the winner will be required to get a 3rd Class Medical if not already obtained before any funds are dispersed. To request payment upon completion of one of the aviation goals, winner must provide a written request with proof of accomplishment to the Sedona Scholarship Committee, who will then notify the treasurer to distribute the funds.

SELECTION

The scholarship committee does not determine the winner. The scholarship winner will be chosen by an independent panel of outside judges on a point system. Consideration will be given for participation in activities that support women in aviation.
